Igor Paunovic is a senior economist specialized in economic development and macroeconomic analysis. He holds degrees in economics from the University of Zagreb, Croatia, and the New School for Social Research, New York City, USA. Mr. Paunovic is currently with UNCTAD (United Nations Conference on Trade and Development) in Geneva working on the issues related to South-South cooperation and regional integration. At UNCTAD, he also worked on issues related to economic challenges of the least developed countries. Previously, he was Chief of the Economic Development Unit of the UN Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean in Mexico City. Before that, Mr. Paunovic worked on fiscal issues and issues related to structural reforms in Latin American and the Caribbean countries at UN ECLAC in Santiago, Chile. At the beginning of his career, he worked for nine years as a professor of economics at the University of Zagreb, Croatia. Besides teaching, his activities included research related to the process of transition from planned, socialist economies to market capitalist economies in the countries of the Eastern and Southeastern Europe. He has written in three languages (English, Spanish and Croatian) on themes related to economic and social development in various UNCTAD and ECLAC publications and in specialized journals such as Harvard Review of Latin America, Cepal Review, Territorio y Economía, Nexos, Journal of International Political Economy, and Ekonomski Pregled. He has also presented his work in numerous national and international conferences and seminars.

Dusan Zivkovic is an Economic Affairs Officer at the Division of Globalization and Development Strategies (GDS) of UNCTAD, Geneva. He holds a degree in and M.Sc. in Economics from the London School of Economic. He joined UNCTAD in 1990, participated in the Cambodian peace keeping operation from 1992-1994, and worked in DGDS from 1994. In the period 2001-2003 Mr. Zivkovic was the special adviser to the Minister of International Economic Affairs in Serbia, and advised the Government on its Paris Club Restructuring and the Investment Promotion Legislation. Mr. Zivkovic represents UNCTAD in the Paris Club, where he attended over 60 meetings over the last 20 years. Mr. Zivkovic is currently the Officer in charge of the Debt and Financial Analysis Unit in DGDS.
